The summer is a perfect time to relax and read! By reading regularly over the holiday you can maintain and even further develop your skills and understanding.

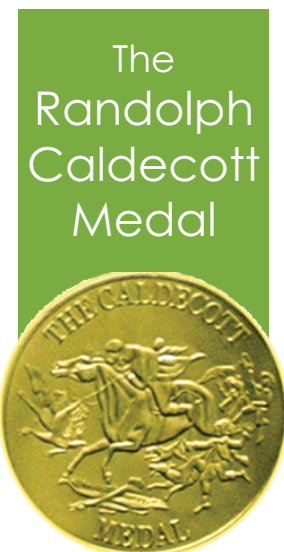
